**MEMORIAL DEALER AGREEMENT**

The undersigned memorial dealer warrants that the person(s) making this application has authorized the dealer to construct a cemetery memorial on the above-described grave(s) and that the attached specifications form contains the specifications and detailed sketch of the cemetery memorial.

The dealer agrees to comply with the Rules and Regulations of the Cemetery now in force or hereafter adopted including but not limited to the following:

1. The Memorial Dealer agrees to furnish the Corporation or the Cemetery a blue print or sketch (to scale) of the proposed cemetery memorial, specifying size, location, inscription, quality of stone and name of person or company furnishing said stone.

2. The Memorial Dealer agrees to make a contribution of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ to the appropriate cemetery Endowment Care Fund as a result of installing a cemetery memorial on cemetery property. The amount contributed to the Endowment Care Fund is based on a percentage of the installation fee the Corporation would charge to install the particular cemetery memorial on cemetery property. Proceeds from the Endowment Care Fund are used for the care and maintenance of the cemetery.

3. The Memorial Dealer agrees to furnish the Corporation with a Certificate of Insurance naming the Archbishop of Washington and his successors in office, a Corporation Sole; and the Catholic Cemeteries of the Archdiocese of Washington, Inc., as additional insureds. The Certificate of Insurance shall be for the amounts deemed appropriate by the Corporation.

4. The Corporation shall have the authority to reject any plan or design for any memorial which, because of size, design, inspection, kind or quality of stone is unsuitable in the opinion of the Corporation.

5. The Corporation reserves the right to stop all work of any nature, whenever, in its opinion, proper preparations therefor have not been made; or when tools or machinery are insufficient or defective; or when work is being executed in such a 'manner as to threaten life or property; or when the cemetery memorial being installed in not as approved by the Corporation; or when any reasonable request of the Corporation is disregarded; or when work is not being executed according to specifications; or when any person employed on the work violates any rule of the Corporation.

6. Workmen employed in placing or erecting cemetery memorials and other structures, or bringing in material, shall, as to the Corporation, operate as independent contractors, but must do so under permission from the Corporation and must be under the general supervision of the Manager of the Cemetery.

7. Persons engaged in erecting cemetery memorials, or other structures, are prohibited from attaching ropes to existing memorials, trees, and shrubs, or from scattering their material over adjoining graves, or from blocking avenues, roads or pathways, or from leaving their material on the grounds longer than is absolutely necessary. Such persons must do as little injury to the grass, trees and shrubs as possible and must remove all debris and restore the ground and sod to its original condition. Work must proceed promptly until completion.

8. Damage done to grave(s), walks, drives, trees, shrubs, or other property, by dealers or contractors, or their agents, shall be repaired by the Corporation and the cost of such repair shall be charged to the dealer or contractor, or to his principal.

9. No material, machinery, or other items used in the construction of vaults, mausoleums, memorials or such structures or cemetery memorials themselves, may be brought into the Cemetery until required for immediate use; under no circumstances shall material, machinery or other items be brought in when a funeral is in process or on a Saturday or Sunday; no work shall be done during said times nor shall such material be placed on grave(s) adjoining the one on which such a structure is to be erected without permission from the Manager of the Cemetery. All work is to be done during normal business hours.

10. The completed work is subject to approval of the Corporation and, if unsatisfactory, it may be removed by the Manager of the Cemetery and any cost associated with removal shall be paid promptly by memorial dealer.

11. Should any cemetery memorial, mausoleum or tomb become unsightly, dilapidated or a danger to visitors, the Corporation shall have the right either to correct the condition or to remove same at the expense of the owner of right of interment.

12. No cemetery memorial shall be removed from the Cemetery except by the Corporation, unless written order of the owner of right of interment be presented at the office of the Cemetery and permission granted by the Corporation.

13. The Corporation reserves, and shall have, the right to correct any error that may be made by its employees or by any other person with respect to locating, placing or constructing a monument or marker within the Cemetery.
